RE: Suspension of in person worship in the diocese of Qu'Appelle

Grace and Peace be with you.

Since the New Year I have engaged in further conversations with the Anglican bishops in Saskatchewan and with our Evangelical Lutheran communion partners. I've had separate conversations with 26 clergy and lay leaders across the diocese, and met with your diocesan executive committee. The shared opinion among all these conversations leads me to announce that the suspension of all public, in-person, worship will extend to the end of January. Before the end of the month, we fully expect that the provincial government will review its current guidelines. In anticipation of this review, I will meet with the clergy of the diocese on January 29 and the diocesan council on January 30, to take counsel together in order to create a diocesan faith-based response and plan going forward into 2021.

The three Anglican dioceses and ELCIC Synod in Saskatchewan share this suspension decision to the end of January.

Notwithstanding, after seeking further clarification on guidelines for church aided food programs, I have given permission for this much needed outreach ministry to continue. If your church is interested in beginning, re-starting, or partnering with an agency or church in your area, I will forward, on request, the guidelines for such a program.

In addition, and acting with the concurrence of the diocesan executive committee, parishes in the diocese now have permission to host funeral services of church members in their church, if so desired. Such permission is given on the agreement that all current government guidelines will be followed.

Thank you for your continued patience and understanding, and thank you for the innovative and compassionate ways you remain faithful and prayerful in these times.
